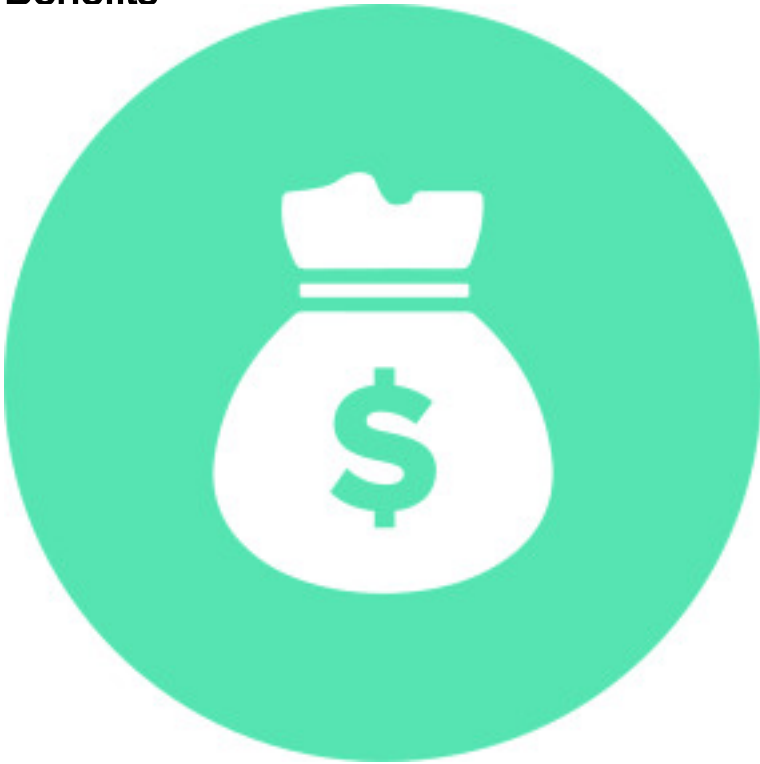
Your Role
